Abstract

The Power Institute for East and Southern Africa (PIESA) is a voluntary association with a particular focus on the electricity distribution industry (EDI) with the aim to improve electrification in East and Southern Africa through sharing information, research, technology, skills and experiences. Priority areas identified to date have been in the areas of applied research, equipment standardisation, low cost electrification, reduction of non-technical and revenue losses, environmental management, technology and skills development.

PIESA's Vision and Objectives have a long-term horizon, and the strategy to achieve it is an incremental process.

The PIESA has established an identity amongst both public and private stakeholders in this region of Africa.
