

Renewable Energy Technology Diffusion: A Report to the Chairmen of the E7

Abstract:

The report on Renewable Energy Technology Diffusion is the culmination of the e7's theme year activities for the 2002-2003 e7 chairmanship term of American Electric Power (USA). The e7 is a group of leading international electricity companies from the G7 nations, collectively dedicated to serving as a forum for global electricity issues and promoting sustainable energy development.

The e7 Technology Diffusion Working Group was tasked by the Chairmen of the e7 companies with the goal of providing a roadmap to improve the diffusion of energy technologies for sustainable development. This report's major conclusions include guidelines for focused and committed actions to address project-level "microbarriers" and recommendations for broad, coordinated cooperation to address policy-level "macrobarriers."
