### Abstract

In January 2006 the 2-year European Roadmap project kicked off. Partners are Eurelectric, KEMA, CESI & Enel, IEN (Poland) and EBL (Norway). The official title is Electricity research RoadMap In Europe; ERMinE. ERMinE's objective is to help the EU authorities in obtaining a comprehensive idea of :

- the current state of electricity RTD in Europe
- plus indications as to the specific needs of the European ESI and of manufacturers over the next 20-25 year

A Vision paper has been drafted and to be amended through workshops throughout Europe (Brussels, Oslo, Warsaw and Rome). Actual, historical and projected RTD&D funding data are collected for specific technology developments and a Roadmap will be developed.
