# The Joint Seminar on Clean Coal Technology



It is well known that coal remains one of the world's lowest-cost fuels for electric power generation today and for the foreseeable future. Therefore much attention has been given to the development of clean coal technologies (CCTs) in recent years as they are expected to play, increasingly, a key role in improving the economics and environmental acceptability of coal use. Rapid advancements have been made in a number of areas of CCT, notably combustion and emission control, which can be applied in countries with coal-based power industries such as Thailand and others in the region. This Pre-conference Seminar therefore aims to disseminate information on recent advances on clean coal technologies to energy planners, power industry operators, engineers/technologists and academics. It is a collaborative effort of a number of Japanese and Thai institutions. The Japanese organizations involved are: Central Research Institute of Electric Power Industry (CRIEPI), and Ishikawajima- Harima Heavy Industries Co Ltd (IHI) under the membership of IERE, and the Thai institutions are : the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment (JGSEE) at King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi, Sirindhorn International Institute of Technology (SIIT) at Thammasart University and the Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand (EGAT).
